The Oregon State Taekwondo Hanmadang is an authentic, nationally sanctioned USTC Hanmadang event. The Executive Director of the National US Open Taekwondo Hanmadang, **Grand Master Doug Fuechsel** will be in attendance. He will also be facilitating the Archery and Sword Paper Cutting competition.

All competitors must provide at least 3 boards for each breaking event (more for combo breaks), purchase during online registration. Additional boards available at the tournament: \$5 for 3 boards. Power break boards \$2 each.

Entry fees

- Friday All Schools, All Styles Open Weapons Tournament and Saturday Taekwondo Hanmadang: Two events: \$80. Each additional event: \$20
- Friday Martial Arts Expo: Free entry/free participation
- Saturday all-day spectator pass: \$5 for ages 6 and up.
- Ages 5 and under: FREE
- Coach pass: \$10 / Referee pass: FREE
